### Let's look at this week's story

Lots of rubbish is being left on the streets of Birmingham. This is because the people whose job it is to collect the rubbish and empty the bins are on strike.

Think about: What is a strike?

Explain that a strike is when people doing a job stop working because they are unhappy. One of the reasons people who collect the bins are unhappy is because they would like to be paid more money for the job they do.

In some areas of Birmingham, the strike has been going on for quite a long time, which means more and more rubbish is piling up on the streets.

Think about: Have you ever seen the bin lorries and refuse workers collecting rubbish on your street? How do they do it? Would you like to see lots of rubbish outside your homes and all along the streets? What do you think could happen if more and more bin bags get left on the streets?
