Fairtrade Policy

Loxdale Primary school is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for the developing world's producers.

As a school, we will ensure that we:

- Support the Fairtrade steering group.
- Ensure Fairtrade is part of the school development plan (where possible).
- Use Fairtrade products wherever possible:
 - tea, coffee, sugar and biscuits in the staffroom and at meetings.
 - in cookery activities.
 - in the dining hall.
 - in games activities.
- Explore purchasing Fairtrade sports balls when buying new ones.
- Explore using uniforms made with Fairtrade cotton.
- Ensure Fairtrade products are available wherever possible. For example, at school events.
- Ensure that Fairtrade is discussed in a range of lessons and in whole school activities.
- Promote Fairtrade within the school and wider community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight.
- Do something each year to promote Fairtrade.
- Celebrate Fairtrade activities through the Black Books (SMSC).
- Ask the local authority to include the use of Fairtrade products in catering contracts for schools, wherever possible.
