Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for all of your help and support in settling your children into our Nursery. We are so proud of them all!

Please could we politely remind you:

- Children will need to bring to Nursery everyday their book bag (we have provided) and a suitable coat.
- PE kit must be worn on a Thursday. Please send your child's named PE pumps in their PE bag (we have provided) these will stay in school.
- Please ensure we are informed of any changes regarding the adult who is picking up your child from Nursery.
- Children will be sent home with a story book every Friday. We ask that these are shared at home, logged on 'Go Read' and returned the following Friday please for changing.

We are working incredibly hard to settle your children into our Nursery, getting to know their new environment, new routines, new friends and the expectations that we have alongside. Using the toilet is something we are also spending lots of time on this year and it is vital we have your support. If you require any help or support with toilet training, please ask a member of Nursery staff. If your child does have a toileting accident at Nursery and we are unable to clean them thoroughly, you will be contacted and asked to come and either collect your child and take them home or to make them clean and comfortable again so they can finish their Nursery session.

Just a reminder, that Nursery finishes prompt at 11:45am and 3:30pm. If children are not collected on time, they will be placed into charged wrap around provision where you as the parent will receive the bill. Nursery staff do not have the time between morning and afternoon nursery to wait for late parents, they have 45 minutes before the next session starts (this is their lunchtime!)

A member of the Nursery team is always available at the start and end of the session, if you have any worries, concerns or questions.
