






How would you rate your experience for booking your appointment slot for this Autumn term parents' evening





How would you rate your experience of logging on for your Parents Evening Appointment?





Upgrade dinner menu to make it a bigger range of different food for the children

I preferred when the years came out at different times and siblings came out together. There were less people on the playground and was easier to exit.

I'm a little concerned that a few topics seem to be London-centric or painting certain political figures such as Winston Churchill as a hero, when to many he was a tyrannical white supremacist. Under his leadership there was the Bengal famine, he had concentration camps set up in Africa in the 50's and he also sent gunboats up the Mersey River to try and intimidate striking workers. I guess what I'm saying is I'd like there to be all parts taught about certain subjects or figures rather than just highlighting the good that happened.

In bad weather condition entrance gate should be opened early so kids don't need to get so much wet waiting outside in the morning.

At this point there's nothing what you could improve as you doing everything perfect.

Support parents where help is needed

The pathway should be fair for every child and not just those with behaviour problems a lot of the time the good children are over looked and do not get as much of a chance to work there way up the path way. I have discussed this before and I have found [REDACTED] has started to be noticed more in the last couple of weeks so I just hope this continues.

I would really appreciate more feedback on my child she's started to use a new pencil at school but teacher has not contacted me to tell me how she feels [REDACTED] is doing with this and it would be nice to hear positive feedback about my child more what she's doing good at and what I could help her more with also if mya is hurt by another child I'm not always informed about this until [REDACTED] tells me lack of communication.

Sometimes feels difficult to approach teachers at the door and at the end of the day for issues that need resolving. I have felt that when I have raised some concerns about [REDACTED] feeling lonely and playing by herself they are not really addressed.

I would like to know more about what my child's day at school, I like online systems such as tapestry

Not sure

Better selection of after school clubs for key stage 2

Sometimes kids don't feel like they are always allowed to explain/listened to if something occurred- their side of story. (Because you can't talk back or defend your argument to a teacher)

I disagree with whole class punishments if one child has done something wrong - it can lead to kids resenting that one child, unfair on others.



Also emotional threats used with no intent to carry out (e.g if they go down the pathway at all they can't go to cinema trip)

This is general feedback and not about current class teachers, just things I've been told about / seen kids upset about. Generally am happy with most things and these are just a few suggestions based on my current work.

Send notices on a need to know basis. Sometimes there are too many notices.

It would be better if the gate was open faster in the morning when the weather is gloomy or rainy. Also, the teachers could stand and tell the children that are running to class to stop and walk.

It would be nice to see more posts for Year 3 Beech on Facebook. Prefer face to face parents evening and other school events. Also good behaviour could be more recognised. Also 30h childcare for nursery children would be a good idea for working parents.

I do believe that there is too much homework given out and sometimes the homework is not based on what they are learning..

Also I feel that us as parents need more notice when events are coming up so we have time to prepare for it and buy what they need for it as it can be challenging for some parents to go and get what's needed if we have more than 1 child to buy or little funds and need to save for it.

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Nothing

Humanity is about improvement, this question identifies that we are not all perfect and the answer lies within question

Communication is an issue for me. On one hand I sometimes feel bombarded by multiple messages (most commonly just a text message telling me that I've been sent an email - it becomes a bit of 'notification overload'), but on the other hand I feel there is a real gap for parents like me, who use wrap around childcare. As a single parent who works full-time, I use breakfast club, after school clubs, and tea time club, so almost never see my son's teacher. Unlike during his reception year (when my working hours were less restrictive) I no longer have that mini update every week or so (it might be just a few words in passing, like, "He's had a really good day", "He's struggling a bit with his reading this week", "He concentrated in maths really well", etc. I don't know what the solution is to this problem. I've been advised to use the class email address, but the one email I sent there wasn't seen by the teacher. Similarly, the school office is never open when I am dropping off/picking up, and emails have gone unanswered, leaving me having to phone while at work (not always possible).

I think a good example of the lack of access to basic updates caused by using wraparound care is the after school clubs. In Reception, [REDACTED] was given some extra after school help for his language skills. In the Autumn term of year 1 he was invited to two 'invite only' after school clubs, but I was not told why this was. Was there a concern with areas of his development? Does



he have additional needs? No-one told me, and when I'm at school, there is no-one to ask. If I was picking him up from the playground at the end of class, I could just ask, but I'm not. There needs to be some consideration for how parents using wraparound care access such basic updates.

Recently I have found that quite a few donations have been required each week. Maybe this could have been spread out over the term. If families are particular struggling this can be quite hard.

Communcation

Information regarding letters/texts could be worded more positively as sometimes comes across in a very authoritian manner. Homework can be excessive and not always appropriate for my daughters needs, however we always complete.

I cannot really think of anything ive never had a problem with the school and how it is run in all the years my children have been attending

Too many texts some duplicated through the week its hard to keep up.

More outdoor/forrest school

Just give us better knowledge for a contact maybe email contact for teachers so we can email any concerns but i do realise that teachers have lives too lol and don't necessarily want us to be able to contact them all the while.

Anxiety and autism in girls awareness could be improves.

Listen to parents when changing classes as can sause immense distress

I think there is all well

Swearing on the playground at pickup times not much you can do about it but not happy when I here it

I'm not sure if this comes under school grounds but the congregation of parents outside the school and on the foothpath is very annoying especially when your trying to walk through and have groups of parents talking away, some smoking away. Not very pleasant for the child or parent

I think the you can have more outdoor activities to help the children interact and consentrate.

More communication around children with sen. Regular updates throughout the terms with emphasis on discussing any targets that are met/changed and what support plan is in place.

The same message sent/repeated multiple times on the teacher 2 parent messaging system

My one suggestion would be not to punish the well behaved children for the actions of the challenging ones in class. I feel they should be the ones missing out on things and moving down the pathway. Single the troublemakers out.

I've been 100% happy with the school until 1st December. I had a phone call stating that my son had a cough and he has to go home. I understand removing him from a classroom was needed but I was not happy with the fact that he was left in a room all by himself, without a staff member being present there. This whole situation could've been handled a lot better. Also not happy that there aren't any after school clubs for reception children, unless I am missing something.

Personally, I am very pleased with the choice of your school. Apart from the language barrier that separates me in the efficient transfer of information, I have no objections. Of course, I am learning all the time and working so that this barrier does not exist

This is possibly more relevant to the current circumstances but given we can't attend things such as sports day, Xmas plays etc, maybe keep the school website/social media more up to date



with pictures of all the children doing the said activities. Although there are some photos put on there, there are only a few.

Nothing in our opinion. All seems great to us

I know in the current climate it is difficult to do, but we would like the opportunity to see examples Evan's work throughout the year.

I don't think there is anything more as a school you can do you do everything and try cover all angles

If I'm honest there's no fault with how the school is run.

It should be given some rights to parents to have their say frequently. As a parent there is no any simple way to say what we think or highlighting some issue .

I personally feel rewarding children for attendance is not a good thing. Some children will never have perfect attendance due to long term illness or parents may force their children to attend to keep attendance up even if it means that the child is only physically there but not there emotionally and mentally. This could have a negative impact on some of the children.

Just to possibly keep an eye out more for children that are having difficulties with other children

I feel, although it is not at all the schools fault and covid cannot be helped, the school experience is so different for the children to how I thought it would be. Pretty much the full time our daughter has been in school we haven't had a normal year. We can't attend for school plays/events/sports days/parents evenings. It all feels like we are disconnected.

I struggle with the online parents evenings, however completely accept that you've done the best you can under the circumstances. I find it difficult to feel comfortable or build a relationship with a teacher that you haven't really had a conversation with. Although this isn't a moan as I know there really wasn't anything else you could do under the circumstances.

School signs on the road with amber flashing lights to warn when school children are about would be a council meeting but would help in the dark months as even tho there are speed humps Cars still race up and down

Senco communication with parents who have concerns needs to be more open minded as parents can feel disregarded
